

Town of Peru Courtesy Sand Policy

Intent

- The Town of Peru will provide a limited amount of salted sand to its residents as a courtesy during the winter months. The intent of the courtesy sand program is to promote the safety, health, and welfare of Peru residents during extraordinary winter weather conditions.

Quantity

- Quantities are limited in order to ensure the Road Department has sufficient salted sand to use on Town roads.
- Peru residents are allowed two 5-gallon pails per storm. Residents are responsible for providing their own pails and shovels. The Town will not load sand for residents.
- Anyone accessing the sand box may be asked to show proof of residency.

Location

- Courtesy sand is available at 85 Peru Center Road in a large wooden bin near the municipal garage.

Availability

- The Road Department will monitor the level in the sand bin during normal business hours only. The bin may be empty at times. The Road Department will restock the bin when their schedule permits.


Authority

- The Board of Selectpersons shall administer and enforce this policy.
- The Board may discontinue the courtesy sand program at any time in order to protect the Town's best interest.


Violation and Enforcement

- Commercial use of courtesy sand is prohibited. Access to non-residents is prohibited.
- A high definition surveillance camera system with remote internet access to view the garage parking lot, sand box and sand shed has been installed to ensure compliance with this policy.
- Violations of this policy including but not limited to theft and trespass will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law and may be subject to a fine up to \$500 for each occurrence.




