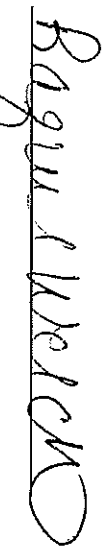
Chairperson Raquel Welch opened the meeting at 7:13 p.m.

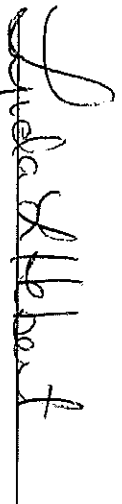

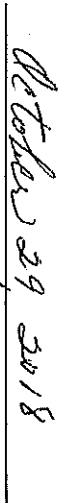
