

Raquel Welch opened the meeting up for Public Participation at 7:55 pm.


9. Public Participation-

- Karen Lark questioned the amount of option two in the change of use warrant article.


Kevin motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 pm., Seconded by Larry. All in favor.


